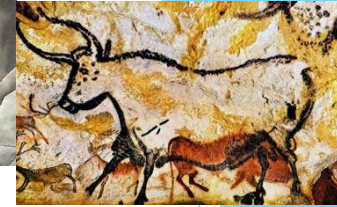
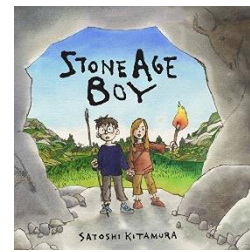

Stone Age to Bronze Age – History/geography driver

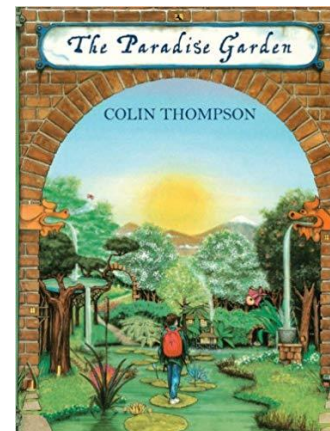
Bodyworks – Science driver

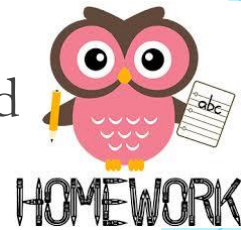
Spellings

Based on our current topics – we aim to cover a range of subjects across the year e.g. history, PSHE, art etc.



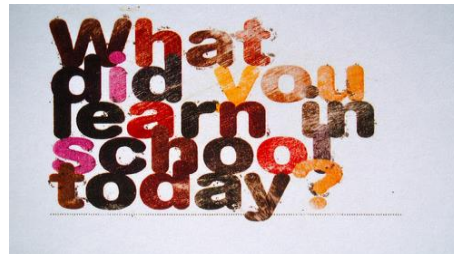
