Parent/Children Information Session

We will be holding an information evening on Friday 27th September straight after school in the hall. You will have the opportunity to learn more about the trip including:

Medical Questionnaire

It is vital that we share any relevant medical details with the staff who will be with the children during their stay away from home. Please complete the attached consent form and dietary forms and return them to school by **Friday 27th September**. All medicines, including inhalers and epipens, must be named and prescribed by the doctor, in their original labelled boxes please and handed to one of the members of staff before departure. Supervising adults will ensure that these items accompany the children when they go out.

Pocket Money

The centre has a gift shop on site selling souvenir items, stationery and sweets. Children are able to bring up to £10 spending money – this should be placed in a labelled envelope or wallet (coins would be preferable to a £10 note). Please be aware that the children will only be allowed to spend up to £1.50 on confectionery. Current gift shop prices are attached.



Clothing List

We have attached a copy of the kit list which shows what your child will need to take with them. All items **must** be named please. Old/inexpensive clothes are best to take and a waterproof coat **is essential**. Wellington boots are not needed but outdoor trainers and indoor trainers are required please.

If you wish to write to your child while they are away we suggest that you give them a letter to pack in their bag. With the centre catering for up to 1,000 people, letters posted may not find us in time. The children are invited to write to you if they wish and so if you would like them to do this, please provide them with a stamped addressed envelope beforehand.
