

Pupil and Service Children Premium

The **Pupil Premium** is additional funding allocated to schools based on census information detailing those children/families who have been receipt of **Free School Meals** (FSM) at any point in the last 6 years or are **Looked After Children** (LAC) who have been under the care of the Local Authority. Currently, for each FSM pupil, a school receives £1320 and £1900 for each LAC.

Schools decide how the Pupil Premium is spent, since it is recognised that they are best placed to assess what additional provision should be made for the individual pupils within their responsibility.

The **Service Children Premium** is funding allocated to schools for those children from service families at any time within the last 5 years. Please inform the school if either parent is in the services or has been in the last five years. The **Service Children Premium** is £300 per pupil.
