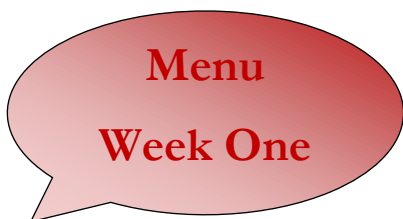
Worship
