



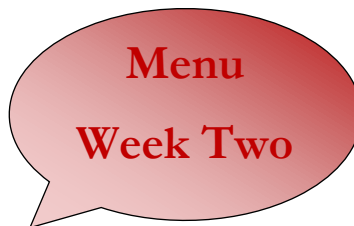

Worship

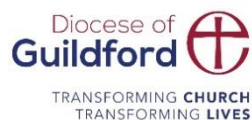
