

HOOK: Introduction to the legends of King Arthur.

OUTCOME: Adventure Story and Play scripts.

LITERACY:

Quality Text – King Arthur and the Knights of the Round Table, Sword in the Stone.

Final outcome: Anthology of adventure stories.

Play scripts based on the adventure story.

SCIENCE:

The children will learn that:
Magnets exert attractive forces with some materials.
Magnetic forces do not need contact and can act at a distance.
Magnets exert attractive and repulsive forces on each other
Magnet forces are affected by various factors.

RE: Protection

King Arthur

Rationale: Explore the myths and legends of King Arthur through comic books, videos and novels. Meet the infamous characters of the Round Table, create your own Knights and battle mythical monsters as you venture on a quest from Camelot through King Arthur's Logres.

- expansion of detail and events supported through vocabulary (the use of technical, vivid language) and explanation.
